TODAY IS DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

Sr Maria Faustina Kowalska was born in Poland in 1905. She became a Sister of Our Lady of Mercy. In 1931 she received a vision, during which the Lord Jesus revealed to the world the great message of God's mercy; calling all to trust in God and to share God's mercy with one's neighbour. Pope Saint John Paul II had a great devotion to God's (Divine) Mercy and in 2000 he canonized Sr Maria and at the same time, established Divine Mercy Sunday as a feast day for the entire Church. "This is the happiest day of my life," he declared on that day. Five years later, on the vigil of Divine Mercy Sunday, Pope John Paul died, so entering into the Mercy of God.
