PROTECT DUTY PROPOSALS ~ The Government is currently consulting on Protect Duty proposals which, if enacted, would place duty on all those responsible for publicly accessible space with a capacity of 100 people or more to take appropriate protective security measures to protect the public from terrorist threat with civil penalties for those organisations in breach.
