AID TO THE CHURCH IN NEED ~ This week launched a new Emergency Appeal to help the starving people of Syria. Sister Annie Demerjian told ACN that deepening economic crisis means people in Syria are *"surviving on one meal a day or less... The explosion of poverty is now worse than in the time of war... Our people are not getting enough to eat... It is very painful to see people, children and women, looking in bins desperate for food."* The religious Sister, who is based in Damascus, also stressed the impact of rising inflation, with UN reports that food prices had risen sharply and that more than 500,000 children under five were suffering from stunting as well as chronic malnutrition.

Sister Annie described key projects she is wanting to expand to meet growing needs including food vouchers, children's clothes and rent money for hundreds of people threatened with eviction for not keeping up their monthly payments. Stressing widespread unemployment, she said: *"So many years of war have paralysed the lives of our people - hundreds and thousands of people without getting any job - so you can imagine life without work, without income."*
