MASS TIMES ~ Along with the rest of Society, our churches closed when we went into the first lock-down on 21st March 2020. We spent the next 15 weeks in virtual isolation. Churches were allowed to reopen for public services on the 4th July 2020 and since then we have put on many extra Masses in order to accommodate social distancing. Our churches have been comfortably full throughout this period, which is a great tribute to yourselves. I would like to take this opportunity to thank Anne and all our Stewards & Cleaners for working so hard in keeping our churches open, safe and welcoming. I would also like to publicly thank our retired Clergy, **Fr. Jim, Fr Ambrose & Canon John**, without whose help the extra Masses would not have been possible.

Now that Government restrictions are being relaxed, it is necessary to return to our regular pre-Covid Mass times: 5.30pm (vigil) Our Lady's // 9.15am St Wilfrid's // 11.15am St Bede's // 5.30pm St Wilfrid's.

However, I am conscious that many of you will be concerned about entering a crowded building, so I propose to retain the 6.00pm vigil Mass at St Bede's and also to include an 8.00am Mass at St Wilfrid's. This will be reviewed at the end of August. We also have the Saturday midday Mass, which I know is popular with many of you.

So from the weekend of the $24^{\text{th}}/25^{\text{th}}$ July Mass Times will be:

5.30pm Our Lady's 6.00pm St Bede's 8.00am St Wilfrid's 9.15am St Wilfrid's 11.15am St Bede's 5.30pm St Wilfrid's

I am still awaiting guidance from our Bishops regarding social distancing and the wearing of face covering after the 19th July. I will keep you informed.
