THE GOVERNMENT ~ Is lifting all Covid restrictions on Monday 19th July and so in theory, are churches will be back to full capacity next Sunday. However, we are very aware of rising Covid infections all around us and so as a Parish, we would like to move forward cautiously, seeking to watch out and care for one another, especially the vulnerable.

Therefore, we are continuing to ask you to wear a **face covering** whilst indoors and to ensure that you **Sanitise** your hands on entering and leaving church. You will not be required to book for Masses in advance, but we would ask you to **sign in** (or scan the QR code) when you arrive.

Stewards are no longer required for safety reasons, but we have decided to continue with '**Welcomers**' who will be there to answer any questions, to put people at ease and to direct you at Communion time. They will also cleanse and tidy the church after Mass. Thanks to those who have already volunteered for this role. If anyone would like to assist them, please have a word with them.

Although **Social Distancing** is no longer required by law, we feel that it is necessary to retain it in some form for those who wish. Therefore, social distancing will be continued at the Saturday midday Mass at St Wilfrid's and also at the 6.00pm vigil Mass at St Bede's. The side aisles will also be reserved for social distancing at St Wilfrid's Sunday Masses.

Please note that from next Sunday we will revert back to our original Mass times pre-Covid. There is also an additional 8.00am Mass, which will be reviewed at the end of August. The Bishops have written, reminding us that there is no **obligation** to attend Sunday Mass at the moment. So why not consider attending a weekday Mass, which tend to be quieter.
