SAINTS THIS WEEK ~ We celebrate various Saints this week, including **St. Teresa Benedicta of the Cross** (Edith Stein) and **St Maximillian Kolbe**. Edith was born in 1891, a Jewess and became a Doctor of Philosophy. She later converted to Catholicism and became a Carmelite nun. When the Nazis invaded Holland she was arrested, taken to Auschwitz and gassed in 1942. She is a Patron of Europe.

Maximillian was born in Poland 1894. He was ordained a Conventional Franciscan and devoted his life to proclaiming the Gospel and promoting devotion to Mary, Mother of God. Like Edith, he too was imprisoned in Auschwitz by the Nazis. There, he endured hard labour and offered his life in place of a fellow prisoner condemned to death. He died by lethal injection in 1941
