MID CHESHIRE FOODBANK ~ “Was established in 2012 and is one of a network of foodbanks affiliated to ‘The Trussell Trust’ a leading charity in the provision of food since 1999. We support people in food crisis; working alongside our referral agencies to give support, not just for hunger, but also the underlying cause.

As you will know a crisis can be reached at any time by any household, it takes a very small change in income to make it difficult to meet outgoing commitments, and that is where we can help. Through our eight local distribution points across Northwich and Winsford (and by mobile services to rural areas) between April 2020 and March 2021 we supplied 8695 people, each had 5 days worth of food, as well as cleaning and toiletries products. This figure is growing each month, it increased by 33% over the previous year and we rely on the generosity of our community at times like Harvest to be able to meet the increasing demand for help that we face.

Support can be either through the donation of long life foodstuffs, cleaning products, nappies, toiletries or by a monetary donation, everything goes towards supporting our clients when they most need help.” Next Sunday we will be celebrating Harvest Festival and donations of food for the needy are invited. These can be left at the back of church. Thank you for your generosity.

RIGHT TO LIFE ~ Baroness Meacher’s assisted suicide Bill will likely have its Second Reading in the House of Lords on 22 October, and the pro-assisted suicide lobby have been further increasing pressure on peers to support this dangerous bill. This has included many members of the public writing to peers with personal stories that make a strong case for introducing assisted suicide.

PLEASE TAKE ACTION

Peers need to know that any assisted suicide law would be fundamentally unsafe and that now is the time to invest in better palliative and end-of-life care instead. For further details go to:
