ST THOMAS BECKET ~ GATHERING

Many thanks to the ten parishioners (including babies Maisie & Jamie) who turned up at our parish meeting last week to reflect on Pope Frances' Synod on Synodality – *As Christians, how do we listen and discern as Church, as individuals?* After a lively debate, we began talking about our own community. A need was felt to develop our parish family, especially after Covid, and so it was decided to look into the possibility of organising a Parish Dinner in the New Year, to which all would be invited. The Parish's involvement with the Homeless in Chester and also the generosity of parishioners to collections for Cafod and the Missions was also acknowledged, but it was felt that more could be done to support the lonely, the poor, the needy, both in our own community and wider afield and to this affect, we spoke about the possibility of rekindling the SVP and starting a Justice & Peace Group. "To Mary God gave his only-begotten Son, whom he loved as himself. Through Mary God made himself a Son, not different but the same, by nature Son of God and Son of Mary. The whole universe was created by God, and God was born of Mary. God created all things, and Mary gave birth to God. The God who made all things gave himself form through Mary, and thus he made his own creation. He who could create all things from nothing would not remake his ruined creation without Mary.

God, then, is the Father of the created world and Mary the mother of the re-created world. God is the Father by whom all things were given life, and Mary the mother through whom all things were given new life. For God begot the Son, through whom all things were made, and Mary gave birth to him as the Saviour of the world.
