UKRAINIAN CRISIS ~ During his General Audience on Wednesday, Pope Francis appealed "to those with political responsibility to examine their consciences seriously before God, who is the God of peace and not of war." And he called on believers and non-believers alike to unite in a joint supplication for peace this coming Wednesday, Ash Wednesday, by praying and fasting. "Jesus taught us that the diabolical senselessness of violence is answered with God's weapons, with prayer and fasting and I invite everyone to make Ash Wednesday, a Day of Fasting for Peace. I encourage believers in a special way to dedicate themselves intensely to prayer and fasting on that day. May the Queen of Peace preserve the world from the madness of war." Pope Francis

In response to Pope Francis' request to make Ash Wednesday a special day of Prayer and Fasting for Peace, please note that the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed for silent prayer and adoration at St Wilfrid's for an hour after 10.00am Mass & from 6.30pm prior to 7.30pm Mass and also at St Bede's after the 11.15am Mass. At Our Lady's, the Stations of the Cross will be prayed after the midday Mass. Please join the World in praying for Peace.
