MISSION APPEALS ~ The feast of St Vincent de Paul is celebrated this week. St Vincent, ministering in Paris in the 17th Century, devoted his life caring for the poor and the marginalised. He died in 1660. However, he was not forgotten for his good works and in 1833 Frederic Ozanam, a scholar, lawyer, journalist and equal rights advocate, founded the Conference of Charity, later to be known as the *Society of St Vincent de Paul*, which sought to continue Vincent's ministry, supporting the most needy of society. This weekend, the Parish SVP will be making an Appeal, not just for funds, but also for new members.

Whilst our Parish SVP work predominantly (but not totally) in the local neighbourhood, we are also required as a parish to have an Annual Mission Appeal supporting poorer communities throughout the world. This hasn't take place for several years due to Covid, but I am very pleased to announce that next weekend we will be joined by <u>Fr. John Convery an Xaverian Missionary</u>. Fr John will be speaking at all the Masses about his work and a retiring collection will be taken for Mission work throughout the world.
