### The Immaculate Conception of Our Blessed Lady

On Friday we celebrate the Feast of the Immaculate Conception of our Blessed Lady. 'A doctrine that teaches that the Virgin Mary was conceived without original sin, that twist in our nature that makes our will tend not to follow what it knows to be right. It was this grace that enabled Mary to give a true and considered "Yes" to the request, conveyed by the Angel Gabriel, that she should consent to be the mother of the incarnate God'. (Universalis)

The doctrine of the Immaculate Conception was almost universally believed over the centuries but was only formally defined as a doctrine of the Church by Pope Pius IX in 1854.
