PARISH FINANCE ~ £1004.25. Thank you for your generosity.

Recently, the Diocese was notified, that from the beginning of this month bank charges would be increased. The most significant increases are around cash and cheque processing. The cost of banking a cheque will rise from 18p to £1.00. The cost of processing cash will now be £1.50 per £100 up from 28p. How can we avoid these charges? Either by using the card/contactless machine at the back of church or by setting up a regular standing order with the Parish.

Similarly, we will soon be ordering boxes of gift aid envelopes for the coming year. These also have rocketed in price, so, again, we are asking those who receive them, if they really require them (do you use them on a weekly basis?), or is there a better way of giving your weekly offering.
